

Athletics P.E.I.

Constitution

May 5, 2015

Article 1: Name and Jurisdiction

- 1.1 The name of the Association shall be Athletics Prince Edward Island Inc., hereinafter referred to as “Athletics PEI” or “the Association.”
- 1.2 The activities of the Association are to be carried on throughout Prince Edward Island.
- 1.3 The registered office of the Association shall be the office of Sport P.E.I., P.O. Box 302 (40 Enman Crescent) Charlottetown, P.E.I., C1A 7K7.

Article 2: Purposes

The purpose of Athletics PEI is:

- 2.1 To promote, encourage, stimulate and develop interest in all athletics disciplines on Prince Edward Island.
- 2.2 To work in cooperation with the defined regions and authorities in conducting organized athletics programs which adhere to standardized and regulated procedures as well as best practises from other jurisdictions.

Article 3: Objectives

The Objectives of Athletics PEI are:

- 3.1 To build a representative membership of duly constituted Athletics clubs and affiliated sections in Prince Edward Island.
- 3.2 To assist in the organization, develop and implementation of Athletic programs throughout PEI.
- 3.3 To consider and discuss issues of mutual concern to each member and member clubs.
- 3.4 To promote and develop cooperation between local, provincial and federal governments, schools, municipal councils, recreation departments, and private

groups in providing and sharing facilities that meet standards acceptable to the membership.

3.5 To act as a facilitator in developing and improving all aspects of Athletics on Prince Edward Island.

3.6 To communicate information to the membership clubs regarding the source and accessibility of financial assistance.

3.7 To assist the development of leadership within the membership.

3.8 To recognize the potential of individuals within clubs in the Province and promote their participation in provincial, regional, national and international competitions.

3.9 To engender communication and public relations among the general public and members as it relates to the furthering of the development of Athletics in this Province.

Provided that nothing contained herein shall permit Athletics PEI to carry on any trade, industry or business. Athletics PEI shall be carried on without purpose of gain to any of its members and that any accretions of the Association shall be used solely for the purposes of Athletics PEI and the promotion of its objectives as set out herein.

Article 4 Dissolution

If for any reason the operations of Athletics PEI are terminated or wound up or dissolved and there remains at that time, after satisfaction of all debts and liabilities, any property or assets whatsoever, the same shall be paid to another organization in Canada having objectives similar to those of the Association.

Article 5 Affiliation

Athletics PEI shall be affiliated with Athletics Canada, the national governing body of track and field or athletics in Canada and thus follow all rules and regulations as they apply to any competitions or related matters.

Article 6 Bylaws

The Association may enact such bylaws, policies and procedures as are consistent with its Purposes and Objectives in order to promote the procedural efficiency and best interests of the Association and its members.

Article 7 Notices and Communications

Any notices to members may be made by email or other electronic communication, advertisement in local newspapers, or such other method as the Board may from time to time determine as to be fair and reasonable.

Article 8 Awards Committee

Annual the Board shall strike a Committee consisting of the President, Treasurer and one other Board member to select the recipients of any Awards which the Association may determine are best designed to promote the development of the Sport on PEI.

Article 9 Board of Directors

The affairs of the Association shall be governed by a Board of Directors which shall be representative of the membership and the Clubs in the Province and which shall be set up under the Bylaws of the Association.
